*4-5 pony knowledgeable parents will be selected to invigilate tests and answer questions as needed, the rest of the chaperones/volunteers will be assisting with setting up tables

2:30pm: ID Tables.

*Straight forward for the chaperone, each table will have items set up during written tests, all you need to do is hand out the paper corresponding to the table you are running

5pm: Clean up tables and get ready for supper.

5:30pm: Supper, provided by SMR.

6:30pm: Youth Meeting and Presentations

*This meeting is strictly for the youth! Please help yourself to some coffee and muffins while the kids put their brains together to come up with ideas for the year.

9pm: Lights out! Please remind children to stay quiet and respectful.

Sunday

8:30am: Breakfast, provided by SMR. Please have children awake (they should know to wake themselves in time) but make sure they are ready for breakfast.

9:15am: Games.
