



Pony Club Camp 2019

Please note: If your child would like to join FPC to attend this camp, please read information included in this document.

Our goal is to provide a safe, fun learning experience, to develop confident, capable horse owners and riders, and to make wonderful memories!

Dates: July 8-12 or July 22-26, 2019

Hours: 7:30 – 5:00 (if you require pick up/drop off earlier or later, please let me know before your camp week starts. **Please not that activities do not start at 7:30 am** – but you are able to drop your child off this early if necessary – they will help feed horses and do morning chores until everyone arrives 😊 **Ideally, all campers will arrive by 8:30 at the latest.**

PLEASE PARK ON SMITH ROAD on “our side” of the street and walk up the driveway when dropping off, picking up or to watch the horse show – we cannot block Smith Road!

Activities:

- Riding (lessons and/or fun rides!) that include experience (skill and age-appropriate) in
 - Dressage
 - Prince Philip Games
 - Jumping
 - Cross-Country
 - Bareback riding
- Fun Horse Show on Friday afternoon (spectators welcome!)
- Driving a pony (tentative – depends if stubborn pony will cooperate)
- Crafts

- Baking (human and equine treats)
- Barn chores/horse care
- Horse movies (if needed due to poor weather or super tired campers)
- Outdoor games and fun 😊

- Braiding
- Clipping
- Bathing
- Longeing a horse
- Free longeing (jumping horse in a chute)
- Photos with horses!
- ETC!

What to bring:

- Lawn/camping chair (**each camper should have their own** – they are not provided)
- Clothing for all weather (including hat and rain gear)
- Medications your child may need (with instructions for dosages/times)
- **Riding helmet** (must be ASTM or SEI approved) – bicycle/other types of helmets are not ideal – if you don't have a helmet, please let me know.
- Riding "**paddock**" boots (they **must have a hard toe and a heel** – boots cannot have a zipper on the inside of the leg (that will irritate horse and damage the saddles) – rubber boots will do if you don't have anything else but they will be very hot!)
- Protective riding vest (not required, but if you have one, bring it!)
 - New vests are available at North Stream Farm Tack Shop in Charters Settlement, and used ones can often be found at Hampton Riding Centre in Hampton, NB)
- Sunscreen, bug spray, hand sanitizer
- Bathing suit, towel, swim shoes, shorts/sneakers/sandals for times when we're not working with the horses directly.
- **Campers must bring all their own food, water bottles and beverages** – but we will have some treats for purchase as well 😊

As with all Pony Club activities, safety comes first. **All rules will be strictly enforced.** Children who are not able/willing to abide by the rules will be asked to leave and no refund will be issued.

Spaces are limited for this camp – please register as soon as possible!

COST

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- Pony Club Camp is
 - **\$300.00 per week** for current members
 - **\$450.00 per week if you would like your child to be a Pony Club member for July-August only** (you will need to fill submit Pony Club paperwork and show proof of NBEA membership for liability insurance). If your child would like to continue their FPC membership from Sept-Dec, this is possible – ask for details!
 - This is to be paid in full by the first day of your camp.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 should accompany your registration. The balance is due on the first day of your camp at the latest.
- Refund policy: The deposit fee is non-refundable. A pro-rated refund of the balance will be issued only with a medical note from a doctor.
- *If you need to make special payment arrangements for your child to attend this camp, please let me know – I want all interested kids to be able to attend 😊*

 - Please note that NBEA memberships can be purchased online at www.nbea.ca. They are \$43.00/child and will provide liability insurance until the end of 2019. **Please also note that the price of the NBEA membership goes up on April 1, so purchase it early if possible!**

If your child loves the Pony Club experience and would like to continue participating for the rest of 2019, please let me know – it is simply a matter of paying an additional \$80.00! 😊

Please note:

- All campers are expected to help with barn chores and horse care, and will be working in teams with instructors and other campers to do all their jobs.
- Please ensure that your child arrives early enough/stays late enough to help with the chores, as much as possible. Children who routinely avoid doing chores miss out on a lot of the fun (and responsibility) of being around horses, and it causes frustration for the other campers. **This includes the barn chores/horse care after the horse show!** Please do not take your child home right after their class – they should be helping take care of the horses.
