Please note: <u>If your child would like to join FPC to attend one of these camps</u>, please read information included in this document. <u>The minimum age is 6 years old.</u>

Please be advised that the DEADLINE TO REGISTER FOR CAMP is JULY 1 - ALL FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JULY 1 - first come, first served. There is no "reserving" a spot without full payment.

PLEASE PARK ON SMITH ROAD on "our side" of the street and <u>walk up</u> the driveway when dropping off, picking up or to watch the horse show - we cannot block Smith Road! No cars should come up the driveway.

- Horse movies (if needed due to poor weather or super tired campers)
- Outdoor games and fun 😊
- Breyer horse activities (bring your own)
- Tacking up, tack care
- Braiding
- Clipping
- Bathing
- Longeing a horse
- Free longeing (jumping horse in a chute)
- Photos with horses!
- ETC!

What to bring:

- Lawn/camping chair (**each camper <u>must have their own</u>** they are not provided) that they can leave at the farm all week (put your name on it)
- Large plastic tote (Tupperware type) to store all their items in case of rain or morning dew.
- Clothing for all weather (including hat and rain gear)
- Medications your child may need (with instructions for dosages/times)
- **Riding helmet** (must be ASTM or SEI approved) bicycle/other types of helmets are not allowed if you don't have a helmet, please let me know. **We do have some that**

- **campers can borrow** but they will not fit as well as one that is only worn by your child. Please LABEL your child's helmet!
- Riding "paddock" boots (they must have a hard toe and a heel boots cannot have a zipper on the inside of the leg (that will irritate horse and damage the saddles) rubber rain boots will work if they don't have buckles or zippers that will make contact with horse or saddle. They MUST have a heel (Bogs don't have a heel, usually)
- Riding breeches (or leggings, etc) long pants to ride in.
- Protective riding vest (not required, but if you have one, bring it!)
 - New riding gear can be purchased at North Stream Farm Tack Shop in Charters Settlement, or Greenhawk Equestrian Supplies in Moncton/Saint John.
 - Used gear can be found at Hampton Riding Centre in Hampton, NB. If you buy a used helmet it MUST FIT properly - ask for help when you try it on!
- Sunscreen, bug spray, hand sanitizer (and/or baby wipes to clean up extra messy hands)
- Bathing suit, **towel**, swim shoes, shorts/sneakers/sandals for times when we're not working with the horses directly. Extra socks are a good idea!
- Toy horses
- Hair elastics or a head band all riders must have hair in pony tail or off their face
- Colouring/Craft supplies
- Campers must bring all their own food, water bottles and beverages but we will have some treats for purchase as well ©
- There is no microwave available for campers to use.
- We do use the house bathroom for camp days, and if we have poor weather conditions, campers may be in the house (under supervision) for movies, crafts, etc. as required. Because of Covid and other illnesses, we will spend as little time indoors as possible.

PLEASE NOTE:

- As with all Pony Club activities, safety comes first. All rules will be strictly enforced.
 Children who are not able/willing to abide by the rules will be asked to leave and no
 refund will be issued. This includes the most up-to-date Covid regulations, if
 required, which will be sent to campers closer to camp weeks if we have to add
 additional precautions such as masks.
- If your child has any Covid/ illness symptoms, you will be contacted to pick them up as soon as possible. Please make sure you let Heather know if they have "other" reasons for symptoms (i.e. runny nose is because of allergies)
- If your child damages property belonging to Shadow Lane Farm/Fredericton Pony Club, they may be expected to pay for repairs/replacement of items/property.

• Your child is responsible for all their personal items - Fredericton Pony Club/Shadow Lane (and its employees & volunteers) are not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.

- IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT A REGULAR PONY CLUB MEMBER (JOINING FOR CAMP ONLY), you will need to fill submit Pony Club paperwork and show proof of NBEA membership for liability insurance. If your child would like to continue their FPC membership from Sept-Dec, this is possible ask for details!
- Camp fees must be paid in full at least one week before your first day of your camp.
- A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 PER CAMPER must accompany your registration. The balance is due one week before the first day of your camp at the latest.
- Refund policy: The deposit fee is non-refundable. A pro-rated refund of the balance will be issued only with a medical note from a doctor/nurse practitioner. If the camp does not happen because of Covid restrictions, camp fees will be refunded (new "camp members" - please see note below)
